August 28, 1829	Mission San Francisco	2500 hides, 204 bags tallow, 7,913 horns, 537 deer skins, 1,341.5 lbs. beaver skins, 3 otter skins
September 3, 1829	Mission San Buenaventura and Mission Santa Barbara	1115 hides, 1845 horns
