




Museum

Before Entering




I will leave waters, backpacks, and food on the bus.

Lining Up




We will line up in our groups outside the museum by the bench.

Protecting Artwork




I will keep 5 feet of space between myself and the artwork. I will not touch any artwork so I can protect it for future generations.

Sketching Station




In the sketching station, I will be given paper and a pencil. Then, I will pick an artwork that I like and will create a sketch of that artwork.
